- 2. The ONOS Scheme has been designed to provide access to scholarly research journals to all Central Government and State Government managed higher education institutions and the research and development institutions of the Central Government. Thirty (30) prominent publishers are included in ONOS.
- 3. The ONOS will be coordinated by a central agency namely Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET), an autonomous inter-university centre of UGC. The scheme will be implemented from 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025. Payments to the publishers will be done centrally by the INFLIBNET. Government of India is paying for this centrally and no part of the expenses are to be borne by the State Governments.
- 4. It may kindly be noted that all research journals published by the 30 most reputed international publishers of scholarly journals will be available to the students, faculty and researchers of the State Government, thereby bringing a vast repository of knowledge for use by the academia. in order to get full benefits of this scheme, you may kindly nominate a senior officer from the State Government, so that all state government Universities and state government Colleges can onboard the ONOS, and provide the contact details (Name, Designation, Mobile No. and Email Id) for further needful. You may also kindly issue suitable instructions to the State Government Higher Education Institutions in this regard to access this window to the world of research.
