WORKING WITH SEARCH RESULTS



- Results are sorted by relevance by default.
- Each result has an availability marker and is labelled as journal, journal article, image, etc.
- Search modifications may be made using the left-hand panel. The search term may be edited, additional filters may be applied, and the search may be narrowed by format, article type, subject, journal, publication date, and availability.

NAVIGATING AN ARTICLE

1 Clicking into the content will show the journal or article, with options to download as a PDF, split screen, view citation and permissions information, and share.

Split view provides two independently scrolling panels: the left for the

2 primary text, and the right to easily switch between contents, figures and tables, references, comments, and related material.

Within figures and tables, options are available to open the image in a new tab or download as a PowerPoint slide.
